This project is due to the continued efforts of the RNCIC (Regional National Cemetery Improvement Corporation), President Ron Butler, Vice President Merle Williams, and all members past and present. Through their combined efforts they are responsible for keeping this cemetery open for future burials until the projected year 2023. There were five World War II veterans who organized the RNCIC in 1984, Mr. Milo J. Cumpston, Mr. John William "Murph" Murphy, Mr. Elvie Heiney, Mr. Ken Gibson, and Col. Larry Brown, Jr. The organization recognized that the cemetery was nearly full and would be closing for new burials, so they began fund raising efforts to purchase additional land. Since 1984 the RNCIC has purchased and donated land, changing the cemetery acreage from 5 to over 15 acres. The RNCIC still accepts donations and continues their efforts for our veterans.
